I. POLICY

It is the policy of the Division of State Patrol (DSP) to allow, whenever possible, persons receiving traffic citations to post bail or a deposit, or obtain release by a means which is approved by law and acceptable to the person receiving the citation.

The Bail/Deposit Procedure Manual is to be followed while implementing this practice.

II. BACKGROUND

Over the years, bail and deposit procedures have been published in a number of formats. Most of the procedures for posting bail or deposits were originally published in Training Bulletins, which are no longer utilized. The information was supplemented in Academy Reviews, DSP Policies and Procedures, and by use of unnumbered memorandums. This had raised issues, while attempting to find guidance. In order to eliminate these issues, the Bail/Deposit Procedure Manual has been published, which contains information concerning bail or deposits.
